Black Thought: Physics, Poetics, Sociology

We will approach, from at least five different angles, an indispensable work by Edouard Glissant called Poetique de la Relation. The first angle is Betsy Wing's translation of the work into Poetics of Relation. The others correspond to the particular disciplinary or interdisciplinary or anti-disciplinary of your ensemble of "teachers." Key terms that will emerge include: relation (in its difference from entanglement); opacity (in its entanglement with blur); entanglement (in its relation to estrangement); incompleteness, connivance; affectability. Together, we will watch some film, listen to some music, read aloud, and meditate on the physics of our encounter. We are especially interested in trying to have some fun!
