Application Form for Matching Scholarships towards tuition 2020-2021

For students in the PACT division, The EGS offers a Matching Scholarship program, in which the university matches money raised by the student up to a limit of \$2,000.00 per student per year. The money to be matched may be raised from any scholarship-providing organization – bank and government loans are not eligible for matching funds. The distribution of matching scholarships depends on available funds and will be disbursed to qualifying students on a first-come, first-served basis.

EGS-PACT matching scholarships are provided in the form of tuition reductions – there are no cash disbursements. Tuition reductions are credited to the qualifying student's EGS account only after the student's matching scholarship application has been accepted and the student has completed payment of the remainder of tuition. Since there are only several matching scholarships available in each academic year, it is possible for students to have their applications accepted and still to miss out on a matching scholarship – due to a large number of competing applications completing the payment of tuition earlier. If you are accepted, please pay the remainder of your tuition as quickly as possible.

Matching scholarships are specific to an academic year. Scholarships must be used in the academic year in which they are awarded. They cannot be carried over to a future academic year.

The current academic year – academic year 2020-21 – ends on August 31, 2021.

Applications may be submitted immediately.

Please note: for an application to be considered, the student applying for a matching scholarship must already have been admitted and must have registered for an MA or PhD program in the Division of Philosophy, Art and Critical Thought (PACT).
